





1 CREATE

This morning I had an idea: Why not make a book explaining how to make a book for free?

So here it is.

I've been publishing books for a while. It used to cost me a lot, but. now I do it for free. So can you.

All the guide books and articles that I found seemed hard to understand, so I thought: Why not make a simple guide book that anyone can use? Here it is. This book is available to order in print or immediately available on Kindle. I uploaded it to Kindle Direct Publishing publishers for free.

All you need is a computer (or laptop, or tablet, or smart phone) linked to the internet.. The Kindle version is handy because it has direct links to web pages. Here are the links to find this book information on the web:

I chose to print this book in 'color'. That costs a bit more but for small books of 24-40 pages or so, copies are not expensive. If you use images or photographs they look better in 'color'.

So if you would like to publish a book like this simple one for free, go ahead. It's easy to do. You can upload it today for free and order copies today. You just pay for the copies you order, from one to any number you want. And authors/publishers get their copies cheaper than anyone else!

What book?

Possibilities are endless!

An easy way to start would be by using your family or holiday photos. Many people have albums on web pages such as on Facebook but books are still popular and welcome, especially as gifts.

You may like to use images as I have done in my Appendix here.

Perhaps you could consider fiction or non-fiction. Most of my books are non-fiction, but I have included fiction stories that a pre-school grandson told me when he was 3 and 4. Uploading many edited copies to the publisher cost nothing as I gradually improved the layout of the book. There's a holiday idea for you with your children or grandchildren.

An older grandson wrote a biography for a primary school assignment so I published that and it became a welcome and popular gift. He did the layout himself. You could help your children or grandchildren make a small book of around 24 pages.

Your children or grandchildren may appreciate your autobiography, or part of your life story. The world has changed so much since the twentieth century that your story could be really interesting especially if you illustrate it with some photos. You could start with some small books and then combine them into one larger volume later.

I have published various essays written by my students and made them available in a book. If you do that you become the editor of that book. Students often gave their work to me with better formatting than I can do myself. I have encouraged students to publish their work, for free.

Maybe you lead or speak in a study group and could gather your material into a small resource book. You can have that published and in your hands within a month, or have it available on Kindle tomorrow! I often use my books as resources for my speaking or teaching.

Why not try something to begin? You may find yourself enjoying this hobby and helping or blessing others in the process.

Book File

Begin publishing with a book file. I have used Word on A5 size with 12 point font, the font size in this book. Most of my larger books use 11 point font size. One advantage of using A5 in Word's Page Layout Size is that it is easy to upload to a 6x9" book, the size of this book.

You can also download a sample formatted template from Kindle Direct Publishing as I did for this book. It gives you the advantage of a prepared layout, including the page numbers. See information on https://www.KindleDirectPublishing.com/Products/Book/InteriorPDF.jsp I use the **Download blank format with sample formatted content.**


So your first job is to complete your book file. Note that sections and chapters start best on odd numbered pages. Blank even-numbered pages before a section or chapter look fine, as in this book.

To publish with Kindle Direct Publishing you need at least 24 pages in your book. If your book only goes to 20 pages or less, you can have blank pages after that. Blank pages make useful space for readers to add notes!

I added images of my books to fill the pages of this small book. You may prefer to add photos of your family and make it a family book that your family would appreciate as a gift from you or for your family members to give to others.

When you insert images into your Word file, do not change the size of the image in Word. That will decrease the dots-per-inch (DPI). Change the size of the image in your original file. Nero PhotoSnap Essentials works best for me because I can resize them there to over 300 DPI, and adjust the print size.

There are, of course, many other ways to make book files and to publish. I'm just sharing what I found useful, and free. Kindle Direct Publishing has many resources and articles you can explore as well.

2 UPLOAD

Now you have your book of 24 pages or more on A5 size, or a similar template, ready to upload to the publisher. This book has 36 pages altogether.

I publish with Kindle Direct Publishing (an Amazon company) because it is free. You sign up with them and they provide all the steps you need. They give you a smart digital copy of your book to see immediately, and then you can make any changes you want before you publish. You can publish at first just for yourself, see how it looks, make any further changes you want (all for free), and then make it available to others.

I took the following steps with Kindle Direct Publishing for this book as I typed it!

If you don't have an account with Kindle Direct Publishing, you can sign up now at https://kdp.amazon.com.

Fill in your details and click **Create My Account.** (If you are under 18 years old, get a parent or friend to open this account for you or use their account.) Then you complete the **Member Agreement.** Reply to the email they send you and then you click **Set Up Your Book Now**.

If you do have an account with Kindle Direct Publishing, just sign in as usual and on your Bookshelf click **Add New Title.**

Choose either Kindle eBook or Paperback (or do both).

Then work through the information needed on the three web pages:

Edit Book Details

Edit Book Contents

Edit Book Pricing

For paperback books you have more options such as black and white or 'color' and book size. It's usually best to g o with their default size of 6x9".

For Paperback books you can upload your Word file as it is, or save it to PDF and upload that. It's usually best to save/print your Word file to a PDF file because you can see any changes needed before uploading it to Kindle Direct Publishing. Before saving it as a PDF file, or uploading it, embed the fonts. Use **Save as / Tools** (bottom left of box) / **Save Options / Embed fonts in file**. Kindle Direct Publishing will automatically embed your fonts but that may change the layout a bit if you haven't done it.

Word now lets you Save as / Save as type / PDF / Tools / Compress pictures / Use document resolution – that gives you a good PDF..

Your book file will then upload, and you will be able to see (and download) a digital copy of it. Take time to enjoy that copy page by page. You can decide if you want to make any changes (I always want to correct something), and then upload your changed file.

You can continue on to the cover at any time. The default cover is glossy. I prefer that shiny, bright version. You can change to Matte for a cover without the shine. Then use **Build Your Cover Online** and **Launch Cover Creator**.

Now your choices are endless. Begin by looking through the pages of designs. Try out a few to see what the default design looks like. Once you choose a design you then have many more choices as you click through the options on the left column. Try all the Themes. You can select from hundreds of images they offer and many designs allow you to upload your own cover photo. I used an image from their 'sky and celestial' group for this book. Then try various backgrounds and fonts.

Exploring your cover options can take you many hours. When you have finished just **Submit Cover.**

Books of 130 pages or more automatically include the title and author on the spine. So if you have over 100 pages you could add blank pages to reach 130 pages if you want spine text.

When you submit your book you can then see a **Full-Size Preview** image. It is worth saving that image. I did that for all the books in my Appendix. Then **Complete Cover** and **Save**, then **Continue** and **Submit Files for Review**.


About one day later you will get an email from Kindle Direct Publishing telling you that you can publish your book, or pointing out an error such as an incorrect or missing ISBN. If approved, even with images of less than 300DPI (as in this book) you can go ahead and publish. Word files often print or upload images at around 200DPI, as for this book.

I suggest you order a proof copy by mail. When it arrives you can check it again. However if you want to make your book available immediately, you can do that – and then correct typos and errors later.

For this book I used Full Color. Small books up to around 40 pages in 'color' cost about \$1.50 more than a black and white copy at the author's discount. You get your digital version for free, and it will automatically have your images as you uploaded them. So I always use 'color' for images even if I print books in black and white. The Kindle version will have 'color' images if you upload that.

Most of the book covers I choose, as in my Appendix, are from cover designs on the Kindle Direct Publishing design pages 1 and 4. For this book I used 'The Mulberry' design, which I often use. I have 20 different versions of 'The Poplar' for my Renewal Journals. See examples on http://renewaljournal.wordpress.com/renewal-journals/.

Postage adds to the cost of each book, not much for America, but more for Australia or overseas. There's Standard, Expedited, and Priority. I found the Standard shipping most useful and quick.

3 DISTRIBUTE

When you have uploaded and approved your book for publication you then choose how to distribute or market it. You can make it available in print and on Kindle, all for free.

I suggest you approve all channels. These include Kindle Direct Publishing, Amazon and other book sellers including expanded distribution. Previously you had to pay for expanded distribution, but now all that is free. You set the price of your book. I prefer pricing at the lower end of the range. Your book description will appear in the book's listing on Amazon and elsewhere.

I recommend you publish on Kindle as well as in print because many people buy digital books now, and can get them immediately. So can you. They have a free download to put Kindle on your computer, laptop, tablet or smartphone.

If you make your book available on Amazon and Kindle you can also get royalties for each sale. Royalties are usually deposited into your bank account. They send you the deposit when your royalties pass \$100. But keep your day job! Publishing is a handy hobby, but you may spend more in buying gift copies of your book than you get in royalties.

Remember, you can upload a new, improved, edited or expanded version of your book at any time, also for free.

However, if you want your book just for yourself (such as a gift for friends) you can leave the wider distribution to later. Once your family or friends see it they will probably want to buy some themselves either from you or from Amazon or Kindle.

You can also buy and mail copies of your book directly to anyone from Kindle Direct Publishing at your author's discount price. That is cheaper for overseas mail than buying them for yourself and then mailing them overseas yourself, which involves two lots of mailing.

For example, today I received an email from Elisha in India telling me about their school library that uses books in English as well as in other languages. I can mail them some of my books for their library directly from Kindle Direct Publishing at author's discount. I have done that for others also.

Enjoy your publishing hobby and bless your family and friends as you share good news.
